North Charleston, SC – Naval Health Clinic Charleston (NHCC) is now participating in the Retiree At-Cost Hearing Aid Program (RACHAP). RACHAP makes hearing aids available at significantly reduced costs to retired military service members. Eligible participants must be fully retired service members and live within 30 minutes of the Naval Health Clinic (former Naval Hospital). Those receiving 10% (or more) disability from the Veteran's Administration are NOT eligible for hearing aids through RACHAP. Anyone interested in obtaining a hearing aid through RACHAP should call the Naval Health Clinic directly at 843-743-3709.
